#### **Mode of Delivery**

Virtual Lecture, Q&A session via ZOOM apps. The teaching medium will be mainly in Cantonese supplemented by English as necessary.

#### **CNE Points**

- A Letter of Attendance will be issued to participants who attended individual module(s). Participants who registered any one of the Modules/ full course without exam will be issued with separate Letter of Attendance only.

## A. Personal Information Collection Statement
